The eclipse starts in one location and ends in another, the times below are for visibility for any location on earth.

Last location to see full Eclipse end	Nov 3 at 2:28 PM	Nov 3 at 9:28 AM
Last location to see partial Eclipse end	Nov 3 at 3:28 PM	Nov 3 at 10:28 AM

* Local times shown do not refer to when the eclipse can be observed from Boston. Instead, they indicate the times when the eclipse begins, is at its max, and ends, somewhere else on earth. The local times are useful if you want to view the eclipse via a live webcam See eclipses viewable in Boston.
