Ranganayaki Rajagopalan (herself a direct disciple of the legendary Karaikudi Sri. Sambasiva Iyer). He continues to enlarge and refine his scholarship and repertoire under the tutelage of Sri R. K. Shriramkumar and Delhi Sri P. Sunder Rajan.

of Padmabhushan Palghat T.S. Mani Iyer. Mali started his learning with Vidwan Late Sri P. Srinivasa Iyer (affectionately Seenu mama) of Madras. Seenu mama spent 40+ years with Palghat Mani Iyer. Mali has taken advanced lessons from Padmashri Palghat R. Raghu. He is currently under the guidance of Vidwan Trichur Shri C. Narendran. Mali has accompanied top notch North

American artists as well as several stalwarts from India such as Sri T.R.Subramaniam, Sri R.K.Srikantan, Sri Sashank, Smt Mala Chandrashekar, Sri Palghat Ramprasad, Sri O.S. Thyagarajan, Sri Kunnakkudi Balamuralikrishna, Sri Vishnudev Nambudiri, Smt Sangeetha Swaminathan to name a few. He has performed in a number of dance productions and world music concerts, notably with Sri Sandip Burman, Shri R. Prasanna and several New England based Hindustani and Jazz musicians. As a sought after teacher and founding member of KHMC (Karnatic Hindustani Music Circle), Mali has been deeply involved in bringing Indian Classical Music to the younger generation of Greater Boston area.

**Samyuktha Sreeram** is an 11th grader at Briar Woods High School in Virginia. She learns ghatam percussion from Sangita Kala Acharya Sri T.H.
