Ayyappa puja Grand Finale Plans for this year 2022 (8-Jan-2022)

- Only immediate family members are allowed to offer and be with you for Irumudi Kattu (prep) and ascending the steps
- A slot will be allocated to every Ayyappanmar for irumudi kattu nirai. Please be present at your allotted time.
 - If you miss your slot, irumudi kattu nirai may have to be delayed. So please be on time and do not delay for all devotees.
- Padi puja will start around 8 am on Saturday after the Lagu Ganapathy Homam.
 - Irumudi Kattu will begin around 8:15 am.
- Starting from 8:30 am the Irumudi kattu slots are going to be allocated
- Ascending the 18 steps (padi yetram) will begin right after Padi Puja
- Ghee Abhishekam will start from 10 AM and conducted continuously
- As soon as the kattu nirai is done all ayyappan mars who finish their irumudi will directly ascend the 18 Steps. Abishekam will be done for the group immediately
- After the Ghee abhishekam the same prasadam will be distributed to devotees and then they can leave for home by collecting their food prasadam.
- At any point of time only those who are doing Irumudi will be allowed in the area where irumudi kattu is done. Please do not crowd the area.
- All other Ayyappan margal can watch the event from our [Facebook live stream](#) page.
- Abhishekam, Alankaram and Bhajans will be live streamed on our [Temple Facebook page](#). Please join from home for the event.
- Depending upon the crowd, our volunteers will request our ayyappan mars to sit in the auditorium and watch the live event from auditorium
- Masks and vaccination is compulsory for all devotees inside the temple premises.
- Please maintain social distance and follow the instructions to keep our community safe.
- Do not forget to collect your food prasadam before you leave from Temple
- Due to COVID related precautions, all devotees are requested not to bring anything from home or outside. (No exceptions)
