Sivaratri

Sivaratri is a very important event that reminds us of our spiritual goal.

There are four purusharthas (goals) in human lifeartha, kama, dharma and moksha. Of these, the pursuit of artha (wealth) and kama (desire) are largely related to mundane matters. But our scriptures tell us that our primary goal should be a dharmic life and attainment of moksha. It is to remind us of these that festivals are conducted and vratas observed. Sivaratri is one such vrata, which enables us to look inward, and spend our time and thoughts more for spiritual and less for material pursuits. The glory of Lord Siva is limitless. Chanting of Sri Rudram, especially on Sivaratri, is considered to be very auspicious. Even if elaborate rituals are not possible, chanting the Panchkshari mantra, which is part of Sri Rudram, will help us develop a spirit of equanimity.

Siva is known as Mahakalesvara—which means that he is the supreme lord of Kala. Time as well as Death share this name Kala. Since every form of life in prakrti (Nature) moves inexorably every second towards extinction, kala, the word for Time, has death built into it. Not only living creatures, but even material objects, such as rocks and metals deteriorate in time.

Mahakalesvara Jyotirlinga

AkasamTaraka lingam Pataaley Hatakeswaram Mrtyulokey Mahakaalam

(In the celestial region this form is called Taraka linga, in the other regions it is known as the effulgent linga, and on earth it is called Mahakala.)

The presiding deity of Time, Siva, rules over the city of Ujjain. The temple of Mahakala dominates the life of the city and its people, in the midst of worldly preoccupations. The icon of Mahakalesvara is unique since it faces the south (Dakshina) and is called 'Dakshinamurti.' The icon of Omkaresvara is consecrated in the sanctum above the Mahakala shrine. To the south is the icon of Nandi, the vehicle of Lord Siva.
